

**COMMODORE:** He/she is the father/mother of the club for the year and chairs the membership meetings, convenes board meetings as required, and is responsible for the newsletter content. Like each captain, the Commodore is not legally responsible for the club. Also serves on the board as Commodore Emeritus for the year following the term as Commodore and as such, heads up the Activities Committee.



**VICE COMMODORE:** Backs up and stands in for the Commodore as necessary. Acts as the club ambassador and membership committee; oversees the processing of membership applications and member cards. Decides which nominees get the coveted (not!) DA Award.



**POWER BOATER AT LARGE and SAILBOATER AT LARGE:** The voices for their respective on-water activities; ensure club activities are planned to include both sail and power boater interests. Keep members informed on relevant boating issues, laws, etc. Serve on the Race Committee when applicable.



**RECORDER:** Keeps the membership meeting minutes. Maintains membership database and is responsible for publishing and distributing the monthly newsletter and email updates as required. Keeps membership forms and up-to-date directory information, provides information as required to officers, members and Webmaster.



**PURSER:** Keeps financial records, manages and reports income and expenses to the club. Pays bills and keeps officers and members informed of all financial issues.
